Our cyber program allows the unique opportunity for students to recover credits not earned from previous school years. A student can enroll in credit recovery courses during the school year through the Freedom Area School District Cyber Program. Credit recovery courses are broken up into the four nine weeks and the students are given a prescriptive test at the beginning of each nine weeks. The prescriptive test allows students to test out of areas that are mastered and only complete those areas in which they need further instruction. The courses are graded on a pass/fail basis. At the end of the school year, the student will receive a "P" for pass on their transcript if they earn an average grade of 60% or above for the four nine weeks of the course. This is a great opportunity for students who do not wish to take advantage of Summer School courses. These courses can be taken in addition to traditional cyber or brick and mortar courses. A student can sign up for credit recovery courses using the cyber enrollment application on the website or can be referred to the cyber program by the high school counselors based on their need for credit recovery courses.
